

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1332 # 15

DIGEST

Prescription drug rebates and insurance plans. Removes a repealer of language concerning passing through prescription drug rebates. Limits the plans that may be offered by certain insurers. Allows a Marketplace plan to seek a temporary waiver concerning compliance with individual and group prescription drug statutory requirements if certain conditions are met. Allows the department of insurance to grant the waiver for a Marketplace plan until December 31, 2024.

- 2 Page 18, line 15, after "provide" insert "**only**".
- 3 Page 18, delete lines 27 through 32.
- 4 Page 34, after line 17, begin a new paragraph and insert:
 - 5 "**SECTION 19. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2024] (a) The definitions in**
 - 6 **IC 27-2-29 apply to this SECTION.**
 - 7 **(b) A Marketplace plan may request a temporary waiver in**
 - 8 **writing from the department of insurance concerning compliance**
 - 9 **with IC 27-1-49 and IC 27-1-50. The Marketplace plan must state**
 - 10 **in the request the following:**
 - 11 **(1) The reason why the Marketplace plan is unable to comply**
 - 12 **with either or both of the following:**
 - 13 **(A) IC 27-1-49.**
 - 14 **(B) IC 27-1-50.**
 - 15 **(2) Verification that the Marketplace plan will comply with**
 - 16 **the statute or statutes for which the waiver is requested**
 - 17 **beginning January 1, 2025.**
 - 18 **(c) The department of insurance may approve a waiver**
 - 19 **requested by a Marketplace plan under subsection (b) for a time**
 - 20 **not to exceed December 31, 2024.**
 - 21 **(d) This SECTION expires January 1, 2025."**
 - 22 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
