

PROPOSED AMENDMENT

HB 1376 # 2

DIGEST

Opioid overdose reversal medication. Expands the locations in which a school must make a federal Food and Drug Administration opioid overdose reversal medication (medication) readily available. Provides that a sufficient amount of medication must be prescribed by the state health commissioner or the commissioner's designee to meet the requirements of the chapter.

- 7 Page 2, line 21, delete "." and insert "**, including:**
- 8 **(A) in a location in the school;**
- 9 **(B) in each school bus used by the school to transport**
- 10 **students; and**
- 11 **(C) at an athletic activity (as defined in IC 20-34-8-2)**
- 12 **conducted on school grounds.**
- 13 **A school may temporarily relocate a dose of the medication**
- 14 **described in subdivision (1) from a location where students are not**
- 15 **present to meet the requirements of this subsection."**
- 16 Page 3, line 6, delete "at least" and insert "**for a sufficient number**
- 17 **of doses of a federal Food and Drug Administration approved**
- 18 **opioid overdose reversal medication to meet the requirements**
- 19 **described in section 1(c) of this chapter."**
- 20 Page 3, delete lines 7 through 9.
