DIGEST

Retail pet store matters. Requires a retail pet store to provide certain information to the state board of animal health upon initial registration or renewal. Provides that a county, municipality, or township may prohibit a retail pet store from selling dogs under certain circumstances.

2	insert:
3	"(3) The name and address of the entities from which a retail
4	pet store obtained a dog for the purpose of sale by the retail
5	pet store.
6	(4) Documentation verifying that a dog obtained by the retail
7	pet store from a commercial dog breeder for the purpose of
8	sale by the retail pet store is:
9	(A) canine care certified; or
10	(B) certified by a national science based breeder standards
11	program not described in clause (A).".
12	Page 9, line 4, delete "(3)" and insert "(5)".
13	Page 14, line 32, delete "A unit" and insert "Subject to subsection
14	(g), a unit".
15	Page 15, between lines 30 and 31, begin a new paragraph and insert:
16	"(g) A unit may prohibit a retail pet store from selling dogs
17	acquired from the following:
18	(1) A commercial dog breeder that fails to meet the criteria
19	described in subsection (a)(1).
20	(2) A commercial dog broker that fails to meet the criteria
21	described in subsection (a)(2).
22	(3) A dog breeder or broker that is subject to 9 CFR 3.1 and
23	has at least one (1) violation for the previous two (2) years.".
