Canine standard of care. Provides details concerning where a retail pet store may source dogs to sell.

1	Page 7, delete lines 8 through 13, begin a new line block indented
2	and insert:
3	"(2) Persons who breed at least seventy-five percent (75%) of
4	the person's dogs as sport dogs for hunting purposes.
5	(3) Persons who breed at least seventy-five percent (75%) of
6	the person's dogs as service dogs or as dogs for use by the
7	police or the armed forces.".

13	only sell dogs acquired from the following sources:

17	(B) Is certified by a national science based breeder
18	standards program.
19	(C) Is audited by an independent auditing firm that
20	complies with the applicable standards of the International
21	Organization for Standardization (ISO).
22	(2) A hobby breeder that meets the following criteria:
23	(A) Is registered as required by IC 15-21-3-2.7.
24	(B) Is certified by a national science based breeder
25	standards program.
26	(C) Is audited by an independent auditing firm that
27	complies with the applicable standards of the International
28	Organization for Standardization (ISO).

1	(b) If a retail pet store acquires a dog from a source that does
2	not fall under the criteria established in subsection (a) or no longer
3	meets the criteria established in subsection (a), the retail pet store
4	shall take the following corrective action within thirty (30) days:
5	(1) Notify the board of the violation and report which entity
6	sold the dog to the retail pet store.
7	(2) Notify customers who purchased a dog acquired from a
8	source not described in subsection (a).
9	(3) Provide a refund to a customer who elects to return a dog
10	acquired from a source not described in subsection (a).
11	(c) A retail pet store that takes corrective action under
12	subsection (b) does not violate subsection (a).".
13	Page 15, delete lines 1 through 9.
14	Page 15, delete lines 38 through 42, begin a new paragraph and
15	insert:
16	"SECTION 31. IC 15-21-6-2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
17	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
18	1, 2024]: Sec. 2. (a) A unit may not prohibit a retail pet store from
19	selling dogs acquired from the following:
20	(1) A commercial dog breeder that meets the following
21	criteria:
22	(A) Is registered as required by IC 15-21-2-1.
23	(B) Is certified by a national science based breeder
24	standards program.
25	(C) Is audited by an independent auditing firm that
26	complies with the applicable standards of the International
27	Organization for Standardization (ISO).
28	(2) A hobby breeder that meets the following criteria:
29	(A) Is registered as required by IC 15-21-3-2.7.
30	(B) Is certified by a national science based breeder
31	standards program.
32	(C) Is audited by an independent auditing firm that
33	complies with the applicable standards of the International
34	Organization for Standardization (ISO).
35	(b) A retail pet store may sell dogs from a commercial dog
36	breeder or hobby breeder that is awaiting a final audit from the
37	canine care certified program until June 30, 2025.
38	(c) A retail pet store shall have an opportunity to take corrective
39	action under IC 15-21-5-6.5 before a local unit prevents a retail pet
40	store from selling dogs due to a violation under this section.

1	(d) This section may not be construed to prohibit a unit from
2	adopting an ordinance or regulating a retail pet store for:
3	(1) inspections;
4	(2) business licenses; or
5	(3) other applicable local ordinances.
6	(e) Any ordinance that violates subsection (a) is void and
7	unenforceable. An ordinance adopted before July 1, 2024, becomes
8	void and unenforceable on July 1, 2024.".
9	Delete page 16.
10	Page 17, delete lines 1 through 3.
11	Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
