## **HOUSE MOTION**

## MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 124 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 2, between lines 4 and 5, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2	"SECTION 3. IC 9-21-8-49, AS AMENDED BY P.L.110-2020,
3	SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4	JULY 1, 2022]: Sec. 49. (a) Except as provided in subsection (b) or as
5	provided in sections 35, 50, 52, 55, 56, and 58 of this chapter, a person
6	who violates this chapter commits a Class C infraction.
7	(b) Except as provided in sections 35, 50, 52, 55, 56, 58, and 59 of
8	this chapter, a person who violates this chapter in a manner that results
9	in bodily injury to a person commits a Class A infraction.
10	(c) IC 34-28-5-6(b) (community service in lieu of license
11	suspension) applies to a person who violates this chapter.".
12	Page 2, after line 36, begin a new paragraph and insert:
13	"SECTION 5. IC 34-28-5-6, AS AMENDED BY P.L.86-2021,
14	SECTION 22, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
15	JULY 1, 2022]: Sec. 6. (a) If a defendant fails to satisfy a judgment
16	entered against the defendant for the violation of a traffic ordinance or
17	for a traffic infraction by a date fixed by the court, the court may
18	suspend the defendant's drivers license. When a court suspends a
19	person's drivers license under this section, the court shall forward
20	notice of the suspension to the bureau of motor vehicles. A suspension
21	under this section begins thirty (30) days after the date the notice of

1	suspension is mailed by the bureau of motor vehicles to the defendant.
2	(b) Instead of suspending a defendant's license under subsection
3	(a), a court may require the defendant to perform community
4	restitution or service (as defined in IC 35-31.5-2-50) to satisfy the
5	judgment entered against the defendant for a violation of a traffic
6	ordinance or traffic infraction. The court shall establish the terms
7	of the community restitution or service, which must be reasonably
8	related to the defendant's unsatisfied judgment. If a defendant fails
9	to comply with the terms of community restitution or service by
10	the date fixed by the court, the court may suspend the defendant's
11	driver's license in accordance with subsection (a).".
12	Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
