HOUSE MOTION

MR. SPEAKER:

I move that Engrossed Senate Bill 124 be amended to read as follows:

1	Page 1, between lines 14 and 15, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2	"(c) IC 34-28-5-6(b) (community service in lieu of license
3	suspension) applies to a person who violates this section.".
4	Page 2, after line 36, begin a new paragraph and insert:
5	"SECTION 4. IC 34-28-5-6, AS AMENDED BY P.L.86-2021,
6	SECTION 22, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
7	JULY 1, 2022]: Sec. 6. (a) If a defendant fails to satisfy a judgment
8	entered against the defendant for the violation of a traffic ordinance or
9	for a traffic infraction by a date fixed by the court, the court may
10	suspend the defendant's drivers license. When a court suspends a
11	person's drivers license under this section, the court shall forward
12	notice of the suspension to the bureau of motor vehicles. A suspension
13	under this section begins thirty (30) days after the date the notice of
14	suspension is mailed by the bureau of motor vehicles to the defendant.
15	(b) This subsection applies only to a defendant who failed to
16	satisfy a judgment imposed for a violation of IC 9-21-8-24 (failure
17	to signal). Instead of suspending a defendant's license under
18	subsection (a), a court may require the defendant to perform
19	community restitution or service (as defined in IC 35-31.5-2-50) to
20	satisfy the judgment entered against the defendant for the violation
21	of IC 9-21-8-24. The court shall establish the terms of the

- 1 community restitution or service, which must be reasonably
- 2 related to the defendant's unsatisfied judgment. If a defendant fails
- 3 to comply with the terms of community restitution or service by
- 4 the date fixed by the court, the court may suspend the defendant's
- 5 driver's license in accordance with subsection (a).".
- 6 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively. (Reference is to ESB 124 as printed February 17, 2022.)
