Summary of Legislation: This bill provides that, on or before July 1, 2025, each law enforcement agency shall adopt and implement protocols to administer drug and alcohol testing to a law enforcement officer immediately after the law enforcement officer uses deadly force in the pursuit or apprehension of an individual.

Effective Date: Upon passage.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The bill will have a short term increase in workload for a state law enforcement agencies to create a protocol to administer drug and alcohol testing. It will also increase workload and expenditures to execute the protocol when deadly force is used by a law enforcement officer. Any increases in workload and expenditures are expected to be minimal and to be done within existing resource and funding levels.

Explanation of State Revenues:
