Your Committee on <u>Public Policy</u>, to which was referred <u>House Bill 1086</u>, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the House with the recommendation that said bill **be amended** as follows:

1	Page 2, line 39, delete ", or to the customer's house." and insert ".".
2	Page 4, between lines 6 and 7, begin a new paragraph and insert:
3	"(g) Notwithstanding subsection (a), if a beer retailer violates
4	the requirement under subsection (a) that beer must be sold and
5	delivered in qualified containers, the commission may revoke the
6	privilege of the retailer under subsection (a) to sell and deliver beer
7	in qualified containers to a customer on the licensed premises.".
8	Page 4, line 18, delete ", or to the customer's house." and insert ".".
9	Page 5, line 11, delete "placed" and insert "Placed".
10	Page 5, between lines 27 and 28, begin a new paragraph and insert:
11	"(g) Notwithstanding subsection (a), if a liquor retailer violates
12	the requirement under subsection (a) that liquor must be sold and
13	delivered in qualified containers, the commission may revoke the

1	privilege of the retailer under subsection (a) to sell and deliver
2	liquor in qualified containers to a customer on the licensed
3	premises.".
4	Page 5, line 38, delete ", or to the" and insert ".".
5	Page 5, line 39, delete "customer's house.".
6	Page 7, between lines 4 and 5, begin a new paragraph and insert:
7	"(g) Notwithstanding subsection (a), if a wine retailer violates
8	the requirement under subsection (a) that wine must be sold and
9	delivered in qualified containers, the commission may revoke the
10	privilege of the retailer under subsection (a) to sell and deliver
11	wine in qualified containers to a customer on the licensed
12	premises.".
13	Page 7, line 12, delete "." and insert "to a customer on the licensed
14	premises.".
15	Page 9, delete lines 7 through 10, begin a new paragraph and insert:
16	"(e) The commission may revoke the privilege of a retailer to sell
17	alcoholic beverages in the manner described in subsection (a), (b),
18	or (c), if the retailer violates any of the conditions under subsection
19	(a).".
20	Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
