<u>Summary of Legislation:</u> This bill appropriates \$2 M from the State General Fund to the Department of Homeland Security (DHS) to be used by the department for the purpose of providing mental health and wellness training for: (1) law enforcement officers; (2) emergency medical services providers; and (3) full-time firefighters.

Effective Date: July 1, 2025.

Explanation of State Expenditures: This bill makes a \$2 M appropriation to DHS to provide mental health and wellness training for specific categories of emergency response personnel. The bill does not create a fund or program, nor direct a specific manner in which the money is to be spent. Providing this training is outside the routine administrative functions of DHS and will increase workload for the department.
