**Summary of Legislation:** *Board Membership*– The bill adds two additional members to the Indiana State Board of Nursing (Nursing Board) and changes the required qualifications for certain members.

*Nursing Definitions*– The bill amends the definition of "certified registered nurse anesthetist". The bill adds the following definitions: (1) "Certified nurse midwife". (2) "Clinical nurse specialist". (3) "Nurse practitioner".

*Expiration Date*– The bill specifies that a license to practice as an advanced practice registered nurse expires on October 31 in each odd-numbered year. It makes conforming changes.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2025.

**Explanation of State Expenditures:** *Board Membership*– Increasing the Nursing Board’s membership, would potentially increase the per diem and mileage allowance expenditures of the Nursing Board annually. However, it is likely any increases in overall Board costs would be minimal.

*Nursing Definitions*– This provision may require form and licensing database modifications. It is not anticipated that this provision would significantly increase Professional Licensing Agency (PLA) expenditures. However, the actual expenditure amount would depend on the modifications needed and the agreed to price to make the modifications between the PLA and their IT vendor.

*Expiration Date*– This provision would codify APRN licenses expiring the same time as RN licenses currently expire (October 31 in each odd-numbered year).
