Summary of Legislation: This bill requires the Indiana Department of Administration (IDOA) to prepare an annual report, beginning July 1, 2023, regarding purchases made by state agencies from the following: (1) A minority business enterprise. (2) A nonprofit agency for individuals with disabilities. (3) A veteran owned small business. (4) A women's business enterprise.

Effective Date: July 1, 2022.

Explanation of State Expenditures: The bill will increase IDOA workload to produce the required annual report in FY 2023 and annually thereafter. The bill's requirements represent an additional workload [and/or expenditure] on the agency outside of the agency's routine administrative functions, and existing staffing and resource levels, if currently being used to capacity, may be insufficient for full implementation. The additional funds and resources required could be supplied through existing staff and resources currently being used in another program or with new appropriations.

Ultimately, the source of funds and resources required to satisfy the requirements of this bill will depend on legislative and administrative actions.
