



COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Homeland Security and Transportation, to which was referred House Bill No. 1246, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

- 1 Page 4, between lines 9 and 10, begin a new paragraph and insert:
2 "SECTION 8. IC 9-32-6-6.5, AS AMENDED BY P.L.120-2020,
3 SECTION 48, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
4 JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 6.5. (a) Except as provided in subsections (b) and
5 (c), dealer license plates and dealer designee license plates issued to
6 licensed dealers under this article are valid from the issue date through
7 the expiration date as follows:
8 (1) Dealer license plates of a person whose business name begins
9 with the letters A through B expire February 1 of each year.
10 (2) Dealer license plates of a person whose business name begins
11 with the ~~letters~~ letter C ~~through D~~ expire March 1 of each year.
12 (3) Dealer license plates of a person whose business name begins
13 with the letters E ~~D~~ through F expire April 1 of each year.
14 (4) Dealer license plates of a person whose business name begins
15 with the letters G through H expire May 1 of each year.
16 (5) Dealer license plates of a person whose business name begins
17 with the letters I through J expire June 1 of each year.
18 (6) Dealer license plates of a person whose business name begins
19 with the letters K through L expire July 1 of each year.
20 (7) Dealer license plates of a person whose business name begins

- 1 with the letters M through N expire August 1 of each year.
- 2 (8) Dealer license plates of a person whose business name begins
- 3 with the letters O through P expire September 1 of each year.
- 4 (9) Dealer license plates of a person whose business name begins
- 5 with the letters Q through R expire October 1 of each year.
- 6 (10) Dealer license plates of a person whose business name
- 7 begins with the ~~letters letter S through F~~ expire November 1 of
- 8 each year.
- 9 (11) Dealer license plates of a person whose business name
- 10 begins with the letters ~~⊕ T~~ through V expire December 1 of each
- 11 year.
- 12 (12) Dealer license plates of a person whose business name
- 13 begins with the letters W through Z expire January 1 of each year.
- 14 (b) Dealer license plates issued to a person whose business name
- 15 begins with a nonalpha character expire November 1 of each year.
- 16 (c) A dealer designee license plate is valid from the issue date
- 17 through the expiration date as provided in subsection (a) or (b).
- 18 (d) The fee to renew the license plates issued under section 1 of this
- 19 chapter is as follows:
- 20 (1) For motorcycle dealer license plates, fifteen dollars (\$15).
- 21 (2) For dealer license plates not described in subdivision (1), forty
- 22 dollars (\$40).
- 23 (e) Fees collected under subsection (d) shall be distributed as
- 24 follows:
- 25 (1) Thirty percent (30%) to the dealer compliance account
- 26 established by IC 9-32-7-1.
- 27 (2) Seventy percent (70%) to the motor vehicle highway account
- 28 under IC 8-14-1.
- 29 (f) There is an additional service charge of five dollars (\$5) for the
- 30 renewal of each set of license plates issued under section 1 of this
- 31 chapter. The service charge shall be deposited in the crossroads 2000
- 32 fund.
- 33 (g) The fee to renew each additional license plate issued under
- 34 section 5 of this chapter is as follows:
- 35 (1) For an additional motorcycle dealer license plate, seven
- 36 dollars and fifty cents (\$7.50).
- 37 (2) For an additional dealer license plate not described in
- 38 subdivision (1), fifteen dollars (\$15).
- 39 (h) Fees collected under subsection (g) shall be distributed as
- 40 follows:
- 41 (1) Thirty percent (30%) to the dealer compliance account
- 42 established by IC 9-32-7-1.

- 1 (2) Seventy percent (70%) to the motor vehicle highway account
2 under IC 8-14-1.
- 3 (i) There is an additional service charge for the renewal of each
4 additional license plate issued under section 5 of this chapter, as
5 follows:
- 6 (1) For an additional motorcycle dealer license plate, two dollars
7 and fifty cents (\$2.50).
- 8 (2) For an additional dealer license plate not described in
9 subdivision (1), five dollars (\$5).
- 10 (j) The service charge under subsection (i) shall be deposited in the
11 crossroads 2000 fund.
- 12 (k) The fee to renew a license plate issued under section 2(b) of this
13 chapter is forty dollars (\$40). The fee shall be deposited in the dealer
14 compliance account established by IC 9-32-7-1.
- 15 (l) The fees collected under subsection (m) shall be distributed as
16 follows:
- 17 (1) Forty percent (40%) to the crossroads 2000 fund.
- 18 (2) Forty-nine percent (49%) to the dealer compliance account
19 established by IC 9-32-7-1.
- 20 (3) Eleven percent (11%) to the motor vehicle highway account
21 under IC 8-14-1.
- 22 (m) The fee to renew a dealer designee license plate issued under
23 IC 9-32-6.5-1 is twenty-one dollars and thirty-five cents (\$21.35).
- 24 (n) In the event of a natural disaster or other emergency that
25 prevents the secretary from processing a license plate renewal, the
26 secretary may issue an order extending dealer and dealer designee
27 license plate expiration dates for not more than twelve (12) additional
28 months."
- 29 Page 10, between lines 18 and 19, begin a new paragraph and insert:
30 "SECTION 19. IC 9-32-11-12.5, AS AMENDED BY P.L. 120-2020,
31 SECTION 66, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
32 JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 12.5. (a) This section applies to licenses (other
33 than wholesale dealer licenses) issued after December 31, 2014.
- 34 (b) An initial or renewed license issued under this article is valid
35 from the issue date through the expiration date in accordance with the
36 following schedule:
- 37 (1) A license for a person whose business name begins with the
38 letters A through B expires February 1 of each year.
- 39 (2) A license for a person whose business name begins with the
40 letters ~~letter C through D~~ **C** expires March 1 of each year.
- 41 (3) A license for a person whose business name begins with the
42 letters ~~E D~~ **E D** through F expires April 1 of each year.

- 1 (4) A license for a person whose business name begins with the
2 letters G through H expires May 1 of each year.
- 3 (5) A license for a person whose business name begins with the
4 letters I through J expires June 1 of each year.
- 5 (6) A license for a person whose business name begins with the
6 letters K through L expires July 1 of each year.
- 7 (7) A license for a person whose business name begins with the
8 letters M through N expires August 1 of each year.
- 9 (8) A license for a person whose business name begins with the
10 letters O through P expires September 1 of each year.
- 11 (9) A license for a person whose business name begins with the
12 letters Q through R expires October 1 of each year.
- 13 (10) A license for a person whose business name begins with the
14 ~~letters letter S through T~~ expires November 1 of each year.
- 15 (11) A license for a person whose business name begins with the
16 letters ~~U~~ **T** through V expires December 1 of each year.
- 17 (12) A license for a person whose business name begins with the
18 letters W through Z expires January 1 of each year.
- 19 (c) A dealer license issued to a person whose business name begins
20 with a nonalpha character expires November 1 of each year.
- 21 (d) The fee for the renewal of an automotive salvage recycler license
22 is ten dollars (\$10). The fees collected under this subsection are
23 nonrefundable and shall be retained by the secretary.
- 24 (e) The fee for the renewal of a watercraft dealer license is thirty
25 dollars (\$30). The fees collected under this subsection are
26 nonrefundable and shall be retained by the secretary.
- 27 (f) The fee for the renewal of a manufacturer or distributor license
28 is thirty-five dollars (\$35). The fees collected under this subsection are
29 nonrefundable and shall be retained by the secretary.
- 30 (g) The fee for the renewal of a converter manufacturer or transfer
31 dealer license is twenty dollars (\$20). The fees collected under this
32 subsection are nonrefundable and shall be deposited as set forth in
33 IC 9-32-7-3.
- 34 (h) The fee for the renewal of a used motor vehicle dealer, new
35 motor vehicle dealer, or automotive auction company license is thirty
36 dollars (\$30). The fees collected under this section are nonrefundable
37 and shall be deposited as set forth in IC 9-32-7-3.
- 38 (i) A person who violates this section by operating on an expired
39 license issued under this chapter commits a Class A infraction.
- 40 (j) In the event of a natural disaster or other emergency that prevents
41 the secretary from processing an application for license renewal, the
42 secretary may issue an order extending license expiration dates for not

1 more than twelve (12) additional months.

2 SECTION 20. IC 9-32-11-17, AS AMENDED BY P.L.174-2016,
 3 SECTION 95, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 4 JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 17. **(a)** A dealer who sells a motor vehicle through
 5 the use of the Internet or another computer network shall deliver the
 6 motor vehicle to the customer, or the customer's representative, at the
 7 ~~place of business of the dealer~~ **dealer's licensed location** in Indiana.

8 **(b) A dealer may deliver a motor vehicle to a location other than**
 9 **the dealer's licensed location in Indiana if the delivery is:**

10 **(1) requested by a customer in writing; and**

11 **(2) commenced from the dealer's licensed location in**
 12 **Indiana."**

13 Renumber all SECTIONS consecutively.
