Summary of Legislation: The bill establishes the Administrative Rules Review Committee. It requires:

(1) an agency to submit a rule and the latest version of the regulatory analysis with any supporting documents; and

(2) the Supreme Court to submit a rule and any economic impact statement, with supporting documents;

to the Office of Fiscal Management and Analysis (OFMA) of the Legislative Services Agency (LSA) to estimate the fiscal impact on state and local government. It provides that if the fiscal impact is estimated to be greater than \$300,000, the rule and supporting documents shall be provided to the Administrative Rules Review Committee for review.

The bill provides that the rule described may not take effect unless authorized by a bill enacted by the General Assembly.
