Summary of Legislation: (Amended) *At School Interview:* The bill allows the Department of Child Services (DCS) to interview a child at the child's school without parental consent if:

- (1) the DCS employee presents his or her credentials or other proof of employment for inspection; and
- (2) there is written proof of exigent circumstances.

School Participation: It also requires that the DCS provide assurances that the child's school, or its representative, has been invited to participate in the case plan process.

Effective Date: July 1, 2021.

Explanation of State Expenditures: (Revised) The bill will minimally increase workload for the DCS to provide case plan meeting notices to a child's school.

Explanation of State Revenues:

<u>Explanation of Local Expenditures:</u> Schools may have additional costs to provide a representative to participate in a case plan process and workload to determine whether a DCS employee may interview a child at school without parental permission.
