

COMMITTEE REPORT

MR. PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Local Government, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 14, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

1	Delete the title and insert the following:
2	A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local
3	government.
4	Page 1, delete lines 1 through 17, begin a new paragraph and insert:
5	"SECTION 1. IC 36-7-2.6 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
6	AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
7	JULY 1, 2025]:
8	Chapter 2.6. Vegetable Gardens and Livestock in Residential
9	Districts
10	Sec. 1. As used in this chapter, "livestock" has the meaning set
11	forth in IC 15-11-5-1.
12	Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "residential property" means
13	property that is zoned under IC 36-7-4 for residential use.
14	Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "vegetable garden" means
15	property wholly located within a person's residential property that
16	is used to grow produce, herbs, fungi, or grains for one's own
17	consumption and enjoyment.".
18	Page 2, delete lines 1 through 13, begin a new paragraph and insert:
19	"Sec. 4. A unit may not adopt or enforce an ordinance or
20	regulation that prohibits or has the effect of prohibiting a person

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1	from cultivating a vegetable garden on:
2	(1) the person's residential property; or
3	(2) the residential property of another person with the
4	permission of the property owner.
5	Sec. 5. A unit may adopt ordinances and regulations imposing
6	standards and requirements on residential property containing a
7	vegetable garden if the standards and requirements are the same
8	$as those \ imposed \ on \ other \ residential \ property, including \ standards$
9	and requirements regarding:
10	(1) height;
11	(2) setback;
12	(3) water use;
13	(4) fertilizer use; or
14	(5) control of invasive or unlawful species;
15	to the extent that the standards and requirements do not conflict
16	with section 4 of this chapter.
17	Sec. 6. A unit may adopt and enforce ordinances and regulations
18	that restrict the keeping of livestock on residential property,
19	including restrictions on:
20	(1) the types of livestock;
21	(2) the number of livestock;
22	(3) accessory buildings required for housing livestock; or
23	(4) the square footage of property required for the keeping of
24	livestock.".
25	Page 2, line 14, delete "2." and insert "7.".
26	Page 2, line 14, delete ":".
27	Page 2, delete lines 15 through 17.
28	Page 2, line 18, delete "(2)".
29	Page 2, run in lines 14 through 18.
30	Page 2, after line 20, begin a new paragraph and insert:
31	"SECTION 2. IC 36-7-2.7 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
32	AS A NEW CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
33	JULY 1, 2025]:
34	Chapter 2.7. Agricultural Uses on Agricultural Property
35	Sec. 1. This chapter does not apply to the regulation of
36	beekeeping by a unit under IC 36-1-28-1.
37	Sec. 2. As used in this chapter, "agricultural property" means
38	property that is zoned under IC 36-7-4 for agricultural use.
39	Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "agricultural use" has the
40	meaning set forth in IC 36-7-4-616 and IC 36-7-11.1-13.1.
41	Sec. 4. A unit may not adopt or enforce an ordinance or
42	regulation that prohibits or has the effect of prohibiting an

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1	agricultural use on:
2	(1) the person's agricultural property; or
3	(2) the agricultural property of another person with the
4	permission of the owner.
5	Sec. 5. Nothing in this chapter prevents a unit from rezoning the
6	property to a use that is not an agricultural use. If the property is
7	rezoned, the use may be continued as an agricultural
8	nonconforming use under IC 36-7-4-616 or 36-7-11.1-13.1.".
	(Reference is to SB 14 as introduced.)
