**Summary of Legislation:** The bill urges the Legislative Council to assign to the Interim Study Committee on Pension Management Oversight (PMOC) the task of studying whether the trustee of the State Police Pension Trust and the Police Benefit Fund should be the board of trustees of the Indiana Public Retirement System. It specifies that the corpus and income of the pension trust shall be distributed to participants and their beneficiaries in accordance with certain provisions.

**Effective Date:** July 1, 2022.
