<u>Summary of Legislation:</u> (Amended) The bill requires all county commissioner districts to contain, as nearly as possible, equal population and compact boundaries (currently, equal population and compactness requirements apply to only Lake County and St. Joseph County). It specifies ordinance or resolution requirements for the division of the county districts and provides for the severability of the ordinance or resolution.
