<u>Summary of Legislation:</u> The bill adds firefighters to the list of persons whose residential addresses may be restricted on a public property data base Internet web site operated by a unit.

Explanation of Local Expenditures: The bill adds firefighters to the list of persons whose residential addresses may not be disclosed on a public property database website operated by a unit if the person submits a written request. As a result, the bill could increase the workload of local units to verify authenticity of written requests and remove the residential addresses of covered persons.

Explanation of Local Revenues: Current law allows a local unit that operates a public property tax database to charge a fee for a covered person to make a written request to restrict access to the person's home address.
