

COMMITTEE REPORT

MADAM PRESIDENT:

The Senate Committee on Environmental Affairs, to which was referred Senate Bill No. 303, has had the same under consideration and begs leave to report the same back to the Senate with the recommendation that said bill be AMENDED as follows:

Page 3, line 20, delete "ethanol that includes, by volume, more than'
and insert "alcohol.".
Page 3, delete lines 21 through 22.
Page 3, line 24, delete "gasohol," and insert "gasohol that contains
more than ten percent (10%) alcohol by volume, next to the place
on the fuel dispenser where the fuel selection is made,".
Page 3, delete lines 31 through 36, begin a new line block indented
and insert:
"(1) makes a finding that the regulations of the United States
Environmental Protection Agency:
(A) require the display on gasohol fuel dispensers of a
consumer warning related to:
(i) engine compatibility with gasohol; or
(ii) the potential effect of gasohol use on warranty

1 coverage; or
2 (B) no longer require a label to be affixed to gasohol fuel
3 dispensers under 40 CFR 80.1501; and".
(Reference is to SB 303 as introduced.)

and when so amended that said bill do pass.
