HOUSE BILL No. 1023

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning general provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 2-2.1-1-2 IS AMENDED TO READ AS
2	FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016]: Sec. 2. (a) The first regular
3	session of each term of the general assembly shall convene on the third
4	Tuesday after the first Monday of November of each even-numbered
5	year to do the following:
6	(1) Organize itself.
7	(2) Elect its officers.
8	(3) Receive the oath of office.
9	(b) If a special session is called before the date set in subsection (a),
0	then the organization, election, and receiving the oath of office shall be
1	held on the first day of the special session.
2	(c) The general assembly shall then adjourn until a day:
3	(1) certain fixed by a concurrent resolution; or
4	(2) when the gavel of each house falls in the presence of a quorum
5	whether or not a day certain to reconvene in session has been
6	fixed.
7	(d) The general assembly shall reconvene in session no later than



1	the second Monday in January of the following year.
2	(e) The first regular session of each term of the general assembly
3	shall adjourn sine die not later than April 29 15 in any odd-numbered

6	SECTION 37, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
7	JULY 1, 2016]: Sec. 4. As used in this chapter, "final day of session"
8	means:
9	(1) April 29 15 in odd-numbered years and March 14 in
10	even-numbered years; or
11	(2) a date earlier than April 29 15 in odd-numbered years and
12	March 14 in even-numbered years, if the presiding officers of
13	each body have:
14	(A) jointly agreed; and
15	(B) publicly announced;
16	that the earlier date will be the final day of session.
