DIGEST OF HB 1033 (Updated March 15, 2021 2:32 pm - DI 137)

Citations Affected: IC 36-8.

Synopsis: Residency of police officers and firefighters. Revises residency requirements for members of police and fire departments to require that members: (1) have adequate means of transportation into the jurisdiction served by the member's department; and (2) maintain telephone service to communicate with the department.

Effective: July 1, 2021.

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL No. 1033

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 36-8-4-2, AS AMENDED BY P.L.171-2019,
2 SECTION 12, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 2. (a) Members of the police and fire departments
4 must: ~~reside within:~~
5 (1) the county in which the city is located;
6 (2) a county that is contiguous to the county in which the city is
7 located; or
8 (3) a county that is noncontiguous to the county in which the city
9 is located but is not more than fifty (50) miles from the closest
10 boundary of the city where the police or fire department is
11 located.
12 (1) have adequate means of transportation into the
13 jurisdiction served by the member's department; and
14 (2) maintain telephone service to communicate with the
15 department.
16 (b) In a consolidated city, a member who was residing outside the
17 county on January 1, 1975, is exempt from subsection (a).

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1 ~~(e)~~ **(b)** A city with a population of less than seven thousand five
 2 hundred (7,500) may adopt an ordinance that requires a member of the
 3 city's police or fire department to comply with the following:

4 (1) Reside within the county in which the city is located.

5 (2) Have adequate means of transportation into the city.

6 (3) Maintain ~~in the member's residence~~ telephone service **to**
 7 **communicate** with the city.

8 ~~(d)~~ **(c)** This subsection applies to a city that:

9 (1) has a population of less than seven thousand five hundred
 10 (7,500); and

11 (2) adopted an ordinance to establish the requirements described
 12 in this subsection before September 1, 1984.

13 A city may require, in addition to the requirements of subsection ~~(e)~~;
 14 **(b)**, that a member of the police or fire department reside within the
 15 city until the member has served in the department for five (5) years.

16 ~~(e)~~ **(d)** An ordinance adopted under subsection ~~(e)~~ **(b)** or described
 17 in subsection ~~(d)~~**(2)** **(c)****(2)** may not require a member of a city's police
 18 or fire department to reside within the county in which the city is
 19 located if the member resides outside the county on the date the
 20 ordinance is adopted.
