

# HOUSE BILL No. 1082

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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 16-46-14.

**Synopsis:** Diabetes assessment report. Requires the state department of health, the state personnel department, and the office of the secretary of family and social services to: (1) collaborate to identify plans to reduce the incidence of diabetes and diabetes complications; and (2) submit a report to the general assembly by January 1, 2016, concerning the financial impact of diabetes and diabetes complications in Indiana and plans to reduce the incidence of diabetes in Indiana.

**Effective:** July 1, 2015.

## HOUSE BILL No. 1082

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 16-46-14 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
2 AS A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3 JULY 1, 2015]:

4 **Chapter 14. Diabetes Report**  
5 **Sec. 1. The state department, the state personnel department,**  
6 **and the office of the secretary of family and social services shall**  
7 **collaborate to identify goals, benchmarks, and plans to reduce the**  
8 **incidence of diabetes in Indiana, improve diabetes care, and**  
9 **control complications associated with diabetes.**

10 **Sec. 2. Before January 1, 2016, the state department, the state**  
11 **personnel department, and the office of the secretary of family and**  
12 **social services shall prepare and submit a written report to the**  
13 **general assembly in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6. The**  
14 **report must include the following:**

15 **(1) The financial impact and reach of diabetes of all types in**



1           **Indiana. The assessment of the financial impact and reach**  
 2           **must include the following concerning payments by state or**  
 3           **federal programs, including state employee health insurance**  
 4           **payments, in Indiana:**

5           **(A) The number of individuals with diabetes being treated.**

6           **(B) The cost of diabetes treatment.**

7           **(C) The cost of treatment for diabetes complications.**

8           **(D) A comparison between the costs of diabetes and the**  
 9           **costs of other chronic diseases and conditions on state and**  
 10           **federal programs.**

11           **(2) An assessment of the benefits of implemented programs**  
 12           **and activities aimed at controlling and preventing diabetes.**  
 13           **The assessment must include the amount and source of any**  
 14           **funding directed to any state agency for programs and**  
 15           **activities aimed at reaching individuals with diabetes.**

16           **(3) A description of the level of coordination that exists**  
 17           **between state agencies and programs that provide**  
 18           **management, treatment, or prevention of all forms of diabetes**  
 19           **and diabetes complications.**

20           **(4) A detailed action plan for battling diabetes with a range of**  
 21           **actionable items for consideration by the general assembly.**

22           **The plan must:**

23           **(A) identify proposed steps to reduce the impact of**  
 24           **diabetes, prediabetes, and related diabetes complications;**

25           **(B) identify expected outcomes of the proposed steps in the**  
 26           **following biennium; and**

27           **(C) establish benchmarks for controlling and preventing**  
 28           **relevant forms of diabetes.**

29           **(5) A budget blueprint identifying needs, costs, and resources**  
 30           **required to implement the plan described in subdivision (4).**

31           **The blueprint must include a budget range for all options**  
 32           **presented in the plan for consideration by the general**  
 33           **assembly.**

34           **Sec. 3. Before January 1, 2018, the state department, the state**  
 35           **personnel department, and the office of the secretary of family and**  
 36           **social services shall prepare and submit a subsequent written**  
 37           **report on the information described in section 2 of this chapter to**  
 38           **the general assembly in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6.**

39           **Sec. 4. This chapter expires December 31, 2018.**
