

HOUSE BILL No. 1082

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 36-7-14.

Synopsis: Redevelopment commission membership. Provides that after December 31, 2017, one of the commissioners appointed by the municipal or county executive to a redevelopment commission must be a member of the governing body of a school corporation that includes all or part of the territory served by the redevelopment commission. Removes language providing for the appointment of nonvoting advisers to redevelopment commissions from the governing bodies of school corporations. Provides that nonvoting advisers serve until a member of the governing body of a school corporation is appointed to the redevelopment commission.

Effective: July 1, 2017.

HOUSE BILL No. 1082

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning local government.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 36-7-14-6.1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.55-2016,
2 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2017]: Sec. 6.1. (a) The five (5) commissioners for a
4 municipal redevelopment commission shall be appointed as follows:
5 (1) Three (3) shall be appointed by the municipal executive.
6 (2) Two (2) shall be appointed by the municipal legislative body.
7 **The municipal executive shall also appoint an individual to serve as a**
8 **nonvoting adviser to the redevelopment commission beginning July 1,**
9 **2008. For appointments of commissioners whose terms of office**
10 **begin after December 31, 2017, the municipal executive shall**
11 **include as one (1) of the three (3) appointments a member of the**
12 **governing body of a school corporation that includes all or part of**
13 **the territory served by the redevelopment commission.**
14 (b) The commissioners for a county redevelopment commission that
15 has five (5) members shall be appointed as follows:
16 (1) The county executive shall appoint ~~all the~~ **three (3)** members.
17 ~~whose terms of office begin before January 1, 2008.~~



1 (2) For terms of office beginning after December 31, 2007, the
 2 county executive shall appoint three (3) members; and The county
 3 fiscal body shall appoint two (2) members.

4 The county executive shall also appoint an individual to serve as a
 5 nonvoting adviser to the redevelopment commission beginning July 1,
 6 2008. **For appointments of members whose terms of office begin
 7 after December 31, 2017, the county executive shall include as one
 8 (1) of the three (3) appointments a member of the governing body
 9 of a school corporation that includes all or part of the territory
 10 served by the redevelopment commission.**

11 (c) The commissioners for a county redevelopment commission that
 12 has seven (7) members shall be appointed as follows:

13 (1) The county executive shall appoint ~~at~~ **four (4)** members.
 14 whose terms of office begin before January 1, 2008.

15 (2) For terms of office beginning after December 31, 2007, the
 16 county executive shall appoint four (4) members; and The county
 17 fiscal body shall appoint three (3) members.

18 The county executive shall also appoint an individual to serve as a
 19 nonvoting adviser to the redevelopment commission beginning July 1,
 20 2008. **For appointments of members whose terms of office begin
 21 after December 31, 2017, the county executive shall include as one
 22 (1) of the four (4) appointments a member of the governing body
 23 of a school corporation that includes all or part of the territory
 24 served by the redevelopment commission.**

25 (d) A nonvoting adviser appointed under this section:

26 (1) must also be a member of the school board of a school
 27 corporation that includes all or part of the territory served by the
 28 redevelopment commission or an individual recommended by the
 29 school board to the entity that appoints the nonvoting adviser;

30 (2) is not considered a member of the redevelopment commission
 31 for purposes of this chapter but is entitled to attend and
 32 participate in the proceedings of all meetings of the
 33 redevelopment commission;

34 (3) is not entitled to a salary, per diem, or reimbursement of
 35 expenses;

36 (4) serves for a term of two (2) years and until a successor is
 37 appointed; and

38 (5) serves at the pleasure of the entity that appointed the
 39 nonvoting adviser.

40 SECTION 2. IC 36-7-14-6.2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
 41 AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
 42 1, 2017]: **Sec. 6.2. (a) As used in this section, "executive" refers to**



1 a municipal executive or a county executive that appoints members
2 to a municipal or county redevelopment commission under section
3 6.1 of this chapter.

4 (b) As used in this section, "school board member" refers to a
5 member of the governing body of a school corporation that
6 includes all or part of the territory served by the redevelopment
7 commission.

8 (c) This subsection does not apply if the redevelopment
9 commission already has a member who is also a school board
10 member. As provided in section 6.1 of this chapter, the executive
11 shall appoint a school board member to fill the first vacancy on the
12 redevelopment commission that occurs after December 31, 2017.

13 (d) Notwithstanding the amendments made to section 6.1 of this
14 chapter in the 2017 session of the general assembly, a nonvoting
15 adviser to a redevelopment commission who serves under section
16 6.1 of this chapter, before its amendment effective July 1, 2017,
17 continues to serve as a nonvoting adviser to the redevelopment
18 commission until the executive has appointed a school board
19 member to the redevelopment commission.

20 (e) This section expires January 1, 2022.
