

HOUSE BILL No. 1123

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Study of civil forfeiture laws. Urges the legislative counsel to assign to a study committee the topic of civil forfeiture laws. Provides that the study committee issue a final report to the legislative counsel containing the study committee's findings and recommendations not later than November 1, 2017.

Effective: Upon passage.

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January 5, 2017, read first time and referred to Committee on Judiciary.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning civil procedure.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) **As used in this**
2 **SECTION, "legislative council" refers to the legislative council**
3 **established by IC 2-5-1.1-1.**
4 **(b) The legislative council is urged to assign to the appropriate**
5 **interim study committee during the 2017 legislative interim the**
6 **topic of civil forfeiture laws.**
7 **(c) If the topic described in subsection (b) is assigned to an**
8 **interim study committee, the interim study committee shall issue**
9 **a final report to the legislative council containing the interim study**
10 **committee's findings and recommendations, including any**
11 **recommended legislation, in an electronic format under IC 5-14-6**
12 **not later than November 1, 2017.**
13 **(d) This SECTION expires December 31, 2017.**
14 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
