DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 7.1-3-21.

Synopsis: Alcoholic beverage permits near schools or churches. Prohibits the alcohol and tobacco commission from issuing, renewing, or transferring an alcoholic beverage permit after June 30, 2016, if a wall of the permit premises is within 1,000 feet from a wall of a school or church. Exempts the following: (1) Premises that were issued a permit under previous law. (2) Certain types of premises, if the school or church does not object to the permit. Makes a stylistic change.

Effective: July 1, 2016.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcohol and tobacco.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 7.1-3-21-10 IS AMENDED TO READ AS		
FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016]: Sec. 10. (a) An application		
for a permit for premises situated within a distance of two hundred		
(200) feet from an elementary or secondary school or church must		
disclose this fact. This subsection applies only to an application for		
a new permit for premises that is received by the commission		
before July 1, 2016. An application for a permit for premises must		
disclose whether the premises are situated within two hundred		
(200) feet from:		
(1) an elementary school;		
(2) a secondary school; or		
(3) a church.		
(b) This subscation applies only to an application for a population

14	premises of the grocery store, drug store, restaurant, hotel, catering
15	hall, or location for which the use of a supplemental catering permit
16	has been approved may not obtain the waiver allowed under this
17	section.
18	(f) (g) If the commission determines that the school or church or
19	school does not object, this section and IC 7.1-3-21-10 section 10 of
20	this chapter do not apply to the permit premises of the grocery store,
21	drug store, restaurant, hotel, or catering hall on a subsequent renewal
22	or transfer of ownership.
23	(g) (h) If the commission:
24	(1) receives a written statement from the authorized
25	representative of a school or church or school as described in
26	subsection (e)(1)(B); (d)(1)(B); and
27	(2) determines the school or church or school does not object as
28	described in subsection (e)(1)(C); (d)(1)(C);
29	the commission may not consider subsequent objections from the
30	school or church or school to the issuance of the same permit type at
31	the same premises location.
