Synopsis: Expansion of produce Rx pilot grant program. Makes an appropriation to the Indiana department of health for the purpose of expanding the produce Rx pilot grant program.

HOUSE BILL No. 1139

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning health and to make an appropriation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2025] (a) **As used in this**
2 **SECTION, "produce Rx pilot grant program" refers to the**
3 **produce Rx pilot grant program administered by the Indiana**
4 **department of health division of nutrition and physical activity.**
5 (b) **There is appropriated from the state general fund to the**
6 **Indiana department of health two million dollars (\$2,000,000) for**
7 **the purpose of expanding the produce Rx pilot grant program for**
8 **the state biennium beginning July 1, 2025, and ending June 30,**
9 **2027.**
10 (c) **This SECTION expires July 1, 2027.**
