DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-46-1.

Synopsis: Ballot language for renewal of a referendum levy. Specifies that a resolution to extend a referendum levy must be adopted by the governing body of a school corporation and approved by the voters before December 31 of the calendar year immediately following the final calendar year in which the school corporation's previously approved referendum levy is imposed. Specifies the ballot language for a referendum to extend a referendum levy.

Effective: Upon passage.

HOUSE BILL No. 1163

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning taxation.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 20-46-1-5.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 5.5. As used in this chapter, "resolution to
extend a referendum levy" refers to a resolution adopted under
sections 8 and 8.5 of this chapter to place a referendum on the
ballot requesting authority to continue imposing a tax rate, which
is the same as or lower than the tax rate previously approved by
the voters of the school corporation.
SECTION 2. IC 20-46-1-8, AS AMENDED BY P.L.166-2014,
SECTION 40, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 8. (a) Subject to this chapter, the governing
body of a school corporation may adopt a resolution to place a
referendum under this chapter on the ballot for either of the following
purposes:
(1) The governing body of the school corporation determines that
it cannot, in a calendar year, carry out its public educational duty

unless it imposes a referendum tax levy under this chapter.



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1	(2) The governing body of the school corporation determines that
2	a referendum tax levy under this chapter should be imposed to
3	replace property tax revenue that the school corporation will not
4	receive because of the application of the credit under
5	IC 6-1.1-20.6.
6	(b) The governing body of the school corporation shall certify a
7	copy of the resolution to the following:

- (1) adopted by the governing body of a school corporation;
- (2) approved in a referendum under this chapter; before December 31 of the calendar year immediately following the final calendar year in which the school corporation's previously approved referendum levy is imposed under this chapter.

SECTION 4. IC 20-46-1-10, AS AMENDED BY P.L.155-2014, SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 10. (a) This section does not apply to a referendum on a resolution certified to the department of local
