DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 7.1-5-12-3.

Synopsis: Use of electronic cigarettes. Adds use of an electronic cigarette to the definition of "smoking" for purposes of the laws that prohibit smoking in certain places.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning alcohol and tobacco.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 7.1-5-12-3, AS ADDED BY P.L.141-2012,
2 SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 3. As used in this chapter, "smoking" means the:
4 (1) carrying or holding of a lighted cigarette, cigar, or pipe or any
5 other lighted tobacco smoking equipment; ~~or~~
6 (2) inhalation or exhalation of smoke from lighted tobacco
7 smoking equipment; ~~or~~
8 (3) **inhalation or exhalation of vapors from an electronic**
9 **cigarette.**
