DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-26-5-4.3.

Synopsis: Superintendent compensation. Provides that a school corporation is not required to have a public hearing relating to a school superintendent's employment contract if the superintendent receives an annual salary increase that is not specified in the superintendent's contract for employment if the annual salary increase: (1) applies to all employees of the school corporation; and (2) is in an amount equal to or less than that received by the employees of the school corporation.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 20-26-5-4.3, AS ADDED BY P.L.148-2012
SECTION 2, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
JULY 1, 2015]: Sec. 4.3. (a) Except as provided in subsection (e), a
least seven (7) days before a contract for employment is entered into by
a governing body and a school superintendent, the governing body
shall hold a public meeting on the proposed contract at which public
comment is heard. The governing body is not required to disclose the
identity of the candidate for superintendent at the public meeting.
(b) Notice of the meeting on the proposed contract shall be given in
accordance with IC 5-3-1 and posted on the school corporation's

- Internet web site.
 - (c) The notice provided in subsection (b) must:
 - (1) state that on a given day, time, and place the governing body will meet to discuss and hear objections to and support for the proposed contract; and
