## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 4-12-1-20.

**Synopsis:** Review of allocations of federal funding. Provides that the state or a body corporate and politic set up as an instrumentality of the state must submit the proposed terms of a program, agreement, or extension granting, awarding, or otherwise providing federal funds in an amount greater than \$100,000,000 to the budget committee for review before entering into the program, agreement, or extension.

Effective: Upon passage.

## **HOUSE BILL No. 1178**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state offices and administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 4-12-1-20 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE

2	AS A <b>NEW</b> SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3	UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 20. (a) This section applies to any proposed
4	federal grant, award, or other agreement:
5	(1) to which the state or a body corporate and politic is a
6	recipient or party under any provision of federal law or state
7	statute, or any extension or any amendment to such an
8	agreement; and
9	(2) that is to be received or entered into after June 1, 2021.
10	(b) As used in this section, "body corporate and politic" means
11	a body corporate and politic set up as an instrumentality of the
12	state.
13	(c) If the amount of a proposed federal grant, award, or other
14	federal funding to be received by the state or a body corporate and
15	politic is at least one hundred million dollars (\$100,000,000), the
16	state or body corporate and politic shall submit the proposed terms

of the program, agreement, or extension granting, awarding, or



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1	otherwise providing the funds to the budget committee established
2	by IC 4-12-1-3 for its review. The budget committee may request
3	that the state, body corporate and politic, or both, appear at a
4	public meeting of the budget committee concerning the proposed
5	federal funding. The state or the body corporate and politic may
6	not enter into the proposed program, agreement, or extension until
7	after the budget committee has reviewed the terms of the proposed
8	program, agreement, or extension.
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SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.
