HOUSE ENROLLED ACT No. 1197

AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning general provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 1-2-14-1, AS ADDED BY P.L.229-2015, SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2021]: Sec. 1. The Republic Aviation P-47 Thunderbolt **known as the Hoosier Spirit II**,

(1) produced in Evansville, Indiana, from 1942 to 1945; and

(2) commonly known as the "Indiana Warbird"; during World War II,

is designated as the official state aircraft of Indiana.
