Requires an advisory public question to be put on the November 2016 general election ballot asking the voters whether members of the general assembly should pass legislation to extend civil rights protections to lesbian, gay, bisexual, and transgender (LGBT) individuals.

HOUSE BILL No. 1221

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning elections.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2016] (a) The county election

(d) If a voter indicates a choice for both statements, the county

2	board of each county shall place the following public question on
3	the ballot at the November 2016 general election:
4	"Vote for only one (1) of the following statements:
5	Members of the Indiana General Assembly should pass

8	Members of the Indiana General Assembly should not pass
9	legislation to extend civil rights protections to lesbian, gay,
10	bisexual, and transgender individuals.".
11	(b) The county election board shall print the following
12	immediately below the public question stated in subsection (a):
13	"The vote on these statements is advisory only. The result of the
14	vote on these statements is not binding on the General Assembly.".
15	(c) The county election board shall format the public question
16	stated in subsection (a) so that a voter can indicate a choice for



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either statement.

1	election board shall not count the vote for either statement.
2	(e) Each county election board shall tabulate the votes cast on
3	the public question described in this SECTION and certify the
4	results under IC 3-12-4-9.
5	(f) IC 3 applies to the public question required by this
6	SECTION except where IC 3 conflicts with this SECTION.
7	(g) The secretary of state shall certify the results of the vote on
8	the public question required by this SECTION to the legislative
9	council.
10	(h) This SECTION expires July 1, 2017.
