DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-20-42.3-2; IC 20-28-5.

Synopsis: Teacher licensure. Requires the department of education to grant an initial practitioner license to an individual who: (1) holds at least a bachelor's degree or the equivalent from a postsecondary educational institution; (2) submits fingerprints and any required fees for a national criminal history background check and has not been convicted of certain crimes; and (3) successfully completes the American Board alternative teacher certification program. Provides that an individual who receives an initial practitioner license by meeting these conditions: (1) is authorized to teach the subject matter and grade levels for which the individual has successfully completed the American Board alternative teacher certification program; and (2) is eligible to receive a practitioner license. Provides that an individual who holds an initial practitioner license under these conditions is a "new teacher" for purposes of the Indiana new educator induction pilot program.

Effective: July 1, 2019.

8	(c) An individual who receives an initial practitioner license

10	(1) is authorized to teach the subject matter and grade levels
11	for which the individual has successfully completed the
12	program described in subsection (b)(4); and
13	(2) is eligible to receive a practitioner license after teaching
14	for at least three (3) years under an initial practitioner license
15	granted under this section.
16	(d) After receiving an initial practitioner license under this
17	section, an individual who seeks to renew an initial practitioner
18	license must meet the same requirements for license renewal as
19	other candidates renewing an initial practitioner license.
20	(e) Except as otherwise provided in this section, an individual
21	who holds an initial practitioner license under this section shall be
22	treated as if the individual holds an initial practitioner license
23	under section 12 of this chapter.
24	(f) The state board shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to
25	administer this section. Rules adopted under this section may not
26	impose qualification requirements that are in addition to the
27	requirements set forth in this section.



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
