## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 16-46-15.

**Synopsis:** Diabetes assessment reports. Requires the state department of health, the state personnel department, and the office of the secretary of family and social services to: (1) collaborate to identify plans to reduce the incidence of diabetes and diabetes complications; and (2) submit two reports to the general assembly concerning the financial impact of diabetes and diabetes complications in Indiana and plans to reduce the incidence of diabetes in Indiana.

**Effective:** July 1, 2016.

# HOUSE BILL No. 1320

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning health.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

1 SECTION 1. IC 16-46-15 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE  
2 AS A **NEW** CHAPTER TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE  
3 JULY 1, 2016]:

4 **Chapter 15. Diabetes Assessment Reports**

5 **Sec. 1. The state department, the state personnel department,**  
6 **and the office of the secretary of family and social services shall**  
7 **collaborate to identify goals, benchmarks, and plans to reduce the**  
8 **incidence of diabetes in Indiana, improve diabetes care, and**  
9 **control complications associated with diabetes.**

10 **Sec. 2. Not later than February 1, 2017, the state department,**  
11 **the state personnel department, and the office of the secretary of**  
12 **family and social services shall prepare and submit a written**  
13 **report to the general assembly in an electronic format under**  
14 **IC 5-14-6. The report must include the following:**

15 (1) **An assessment of the financial impact and reach of**  
16 **diabetes of all types in Indiana. The assessment must include**  
17 **the following concerning payments by state or federal**



1 programs, including state employee health insurance  
2 payments, in Indiana:

3 (A) The number of individuals diagnosed with diabetes.

4 (B) The aggregate cost of diabetes treatment to medical  
5 facilities, pharmacies, nursing homes, state agencies,  
6 insurance companies, and patients.

7 (C) The cost of treatment for diabetes complications.

8 (D) A comparison between the costs of diabetes and the  
9 costs of other chronic diseases to state and federal  
10 programs.

11 (2) An assessment of the benefits of implemented programs  
12 and activities aimed at controlling and preventing diabetes.  
13 The assessment must include the amount and source of any  
14 funding directed to any state agency for programs and  
15 activities aimed at the prevention of diabetes.

16 (3) A description of the level of coordination that exists among  
17 state agencies and state or local programs that provide  
18 management, treatment, or prevention of all forms of diabetes  
19 and diabetes complications.

20 (4) A detailed action plan for the treatment and prevention of  
21 diabetes, with a range of actionable items for consideration by  
22 the general assembly. The plan must:

23 (A) identify proposed steps to reduce the impact of  
24 diabetes, prediabetes, and related diabetes complications;

25 (B) identify expected outcomes of the proposed steps in the  
26 following biennium; and

27 (C) establish benchmarks for controlling and preventing  
28 all types of diabetes.

29 (5) A budget blueprint identifying costs and resources  
30 required to implement the plan described in subdivision (4).  
31 The blueprint must include a budget range for all options  
32 presented in the plan for consideration by the general  
33 assembly, including:

34 (A) the actual cost of current state and local programs;  
35 and

36 (B) the estimated cost of proposed state and local  
37 programs.

38 Sec. 3. Not later than February 1, 2019, the state department,  
39 the state personnel department, and the office of the secretary of  
40 family and social services shall prepare and submit to the general  
41 assembly a subsequent written report on the information described  
42 in section 2 of this chapter. The report must be submitted in an
