DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Recycling operations study. Urges the legislative council to assign to the appropriate interim study committee the task of studying the recycling operations of solid waste management districts and how to promote the economic viability of those recycling operations.

Effective: Upon passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning environmental law.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] **(a) The legislative**
2 **council is urged to assign to an appropriate interim study**
3 **committee the task of studying:**
4 **(1) the recycling operations of solid waste management**
5 **districts established under IC 13-21; and**
6 **(2) how to promote the economic viability of those recycling**
7 **operations, including the possibility of reimbursing the costs**
8 **of the recycling operations.**
9 **(b) This SECTION expires January 1, 2022.**
10 SECTION 2. **An emergency is declared for this act.**
