PRINTING CODE. Amendments: Whenever an existing statute (or a section of the Indiana Constitution) is being amended, the text of the existing provision will appear in this style type, additions will appear in **this style type**, and deletions will appear in ~~this style type~~.

Additions: Whenever a new statutory provision is being enacted (or a new constitutional provision adopted), the text of the new provision will appear in **this style type**. Also, the word **NEW** will appear in that style type in the introductory clause of each SECTION that adds a new provision to the Indiana Code or the Indiana Constitution.

Conflict reconciliation: Text in a statute in *this style type* or ~~this style type~~ reconciles conflicts between statutes enacted by the 2019 Regular Session of the General Assembly.

## HOUSE ENROLLED ACT No. 1334

---

AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning environmental law.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

SECTION 1. IC 16-41-38-2.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE AS A **NEW SECTION** TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2020]: **Sec. 2.5. (a) The state department shall adopt emergency rules in the manner provided under IC 4-22-2-37.1 to amend provisions in 410 IAC 5.1 that concern the following:**

(1) **The certification and standards requirements recommended by the federal Environmental Protection Agency applicable to:**

- (A) radon testing;
- (B) radon mitigation; and
- (C) laboratory analysis.

(2) **Revisions and updates to the administrative rule's definitions and exclusions.**

**(b) Before December 31, 2021, the state department shall adopt rules under IC 4-22-2 to amend provisions in 410 IAC 5.1 that concern the following:**

(1) **The certification and standards requirements recommended by the federal Environmental Protection Agency applicable to:**

- (A) radon testing;
- (B) radon mitigation; and

- (C) laboratory analysis.**
- (2) Revisions and updates to the administrative rule's definitions and exclusions.**
- (c) This section expires July 1, 2022.**
