DIGEST OF HB 1341 (Updated January 22, 2020 12:47 pm - DI 116)

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Students with disabilities. Requires the state advisory council on the education of children with disabilities to develop a plan, before October 1, 2020, to inform former students who received a certificate of completion or another nondiploma certificate of recognition and certain students with an individualized education program who withdrew from school of certain training or education opportunities.

Effective: Upon passage.

HOUSE BILL No. 1341

A BILL FOR AN ACT concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE] (a) The definitions
2	in IC 20 apply throughout this SECTION.
3	(b) The state advisory council on the education of children with
4	disabilities established under IC 20-35-3-1 shall develop a plan to
5	inform:
6	(1) former students who received a certificate of completion
7	or another nondiploma certificate of recognition after
8	December 31, 1999; or
9	(2) former students who:
10	(A) had:
11	(i) an individualized education program;
12	(ii) a plan developed under Section 504 of the federal
13	Rehabilitation Act, 29 U.S.C. 794;
14	(iii) a service plan developed under 511 IAC 7-34; or
15	(iv) a choice scholarship education plan developed under
16	511 IAC 7-49; and
17	(B) withdrew from school after December 31, 1999, and
18	who were at least sixteen (16) years of age on the date of

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1	withdrawal;
2	of opportunities described in subsection (c).
3	(c) Former students described in subsection (b) should be
4	informed of:
5	(1) opportunities to earn an alternative diploma described in
6	IC 20-32-4-14 or a high school equivalency certificate;
7	(2) resources available to the individual regarding
8	employment services; and
9	(3) vocational training opportunities.
10	(d) The plan must include:
11	(1) a description of how to contact former students described
12	in subsection (b); and
13	(2) the creation of a list of resources described is subsection
14	(c)(2) and $(c)(3)$.
15	(e) The state advisory council shall submit a copy of the plan
16	developed under subsection (b) to the general assembly, in an
17	electronic format under IC 5-14-6, before October 1, 2020.
18	(f) This SECTION expires January 1, 2022.
