HOUSE ENROLLED ACT No. 1349

AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning pensions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 10-12-2-4, AS AMENDED BY P.L.61-2013, SECTION 1, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2019]: Sec. 4. The department may establish, operate, and make necessary contributions to a mortality reserve account for the payment of supplementary death benefits to deceased employee beneficiaries. However, a supplementary death benefit may not exceed

- (1) fourteen thousand five hundred dollars (\$14,500), for an employee beneficiary who dies before July 1, 2013; or
- (2) twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000). for an employee beneficiary who dies after June 30, 2013.

The department may not use a deceased employee beneficiary's retirement date with the department as a factor in determining the amount of the deceased employee beneficiary's supplementary death benefit.
