

HOUSE BILL No. 1393

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 20-28-5-25.

Synopsis: Teacher training. Provides that 15 of the total number of professional growth experience points required to renew a practitioner teacher license or accomplished practitioner license may (instead of must) be obtained through the completion of: (1) an externship with a company; or (2) professional development with a local business.

Effective: Upon passage.

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A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

- 1 SECTION 1. IC 20-28-5-25, AS ADDED BY P.L.143-2019,
2 SECTION 20, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
3 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 25. (a) This section applies to a professional
4 growth plan that begins after July 1, 2019.

7 accomplished practitioner license ~~must~~ **may** be obtained through the
8 completion of one (1) or more of the following:
9 (1) An externship with a company.
10 (2) Professional development provided by the state, a local
11 business, or a community partner that provides opportunities for
12 schools and employers to partner in promoting career navigation.
13 (3) Professional development provided by the state, a local
14 business, or a community partner that outlines the:
15 (A) current and future economic needs of the community,
16 state, nation, and globe; and
17 (B) ways in which the current and future economic needs



1 described in clause (A) can be disseminated to students.
2 **SECTION 2. An emergency is declared for this act.**
