

HOUSE BILL No. 1400

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 12-15-1.3.

Synopsis: Community habilitation and family supports waivers. Requires the office of the secretary of family and social services to extend the time in which a provider has to file a timely reimbursement claim when providing services under the fee for service community habilitation and family supports Medicaid waiver (waiver). Prohibits the office of the secretary from establishing or otherwise requiring ratios for the number of individuals to be provided day habilitation services in a group setting for reimbursement under the waiver.

Effective: Upon passage; March 1, 2020 (retroactive).

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January 14, 2021, read first time and referred to Committee on Public Health.

HOUSE BILL No. 1400

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning human services.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 12-15-1.3-18.2 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
2 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE MARCH 1, 2020 (RETROACTIVE)]: **Sec. 18.2. The**
4 **office of the secretary shall, during a disaster emergency as**
5 **declared by the governor issued, renewed, or extended under**
6 **IC 10-14-3-12, extend the time in which a provider providing**
7 **services under the fee for service community habilitation and**
8 **family supports Medicaid waiver has to file a timely**
9 **reimbursement claim to three hundred sixty-five (365) days from**
10 **the date of point of service, for the duration of the disaster**
11 **emergency.**

12 SECTION 2. IC 12-15-1.3-18.5 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA
13 CODE AS A **NEW** SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS
14 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: **Sec. 18.5. (a) The office of the**
15 **secretary and the division of disability and rehabilitative services**
16 **may not establish or otherwise require ratios for the number of**
17 **individuals to be provided day habilitation services in a group**

3 (b) The office of the secretary shall apply to the United States
