

# HOUSE BILL No. 1406

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## DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

**Citations Affected:** IC 32-26-9; IC 34-30-2-140.

**Synopsis:** Partition fences. Repeals provisions requiring the owners of adjoining parcels, at least one of which is agricultural land, to evenly split the costs of building, rebuilding, and repairing a partition fence separating the parcels. Makes a conforming amendment.

**Effective:** July 1, 2022.
