## HOUSE BILL No. 1415

DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 5-2-21.

**Synopsis:** Transfers of surplus military equipment. Prohibits certain law enforcement agencies from receiving firearms, ammunition, and armored military vehicles under a surplus military equipment program of the federal government.

Effective: July 1, 2015.

## Introduced

## **HOUSE BILL No. 1415**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning state and local administration.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

15	Sec. 2. A law enforcement agency may not purchase, apply for,



- or receive any of the following surplus property that is made 1
- 2 available for transfer by the United States Department of Defense 3
- under the authority of 10 U.S.C. 2576:
- (1) Firearms. 4 5
  - (2) Ammunition.
- 6 (3) Mine resistant ambush protected (MRAP) vehicles.
