DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Synopsis: Average daily membership. Provides that for purposes of determining the adjusted average daily membership (ADM) for distributions for state fiscal years beginning after June 30, 2017, a school corporation's February count of ADM for a high school within the school corporation is the high school's February count of ADM, plus the number of students who are in their fourth year of high school and were included in the high school's September count of ADM who graduated with a Core 40 or an academic honor's degree before the February count of ADM.

Effective: July 1, 2017.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

SECTION 1. IC 20-43-4-7, AS AMENDED BY P.L.213-2015,
SECTION 214, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
[EFFECTIVE JULY 1, 2017]: Sec. 7. (a) For purposes of this article
and except as provided in subsection (b), a school corporation's
"adjusted ADM" for the current year is the school corporation's current
ADM.

(b) For purposes of determining the adjusted ADM for distributions for state fiscal years beginning after June 30, 2017, a school corporation's February count of ADM for a high school within the school corporation, regardless of the actual amount of the February count of ADM, is the high school's February count of ADM, plus the number of students who are in their fourth year of high school and were included in the high school's September count of ADM who graduated with a Core 40 or an academic honor's degree before the February count of ADM.
