DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: IC 9-29-17-1; IC 9-32.

Synopsis: Wholesale auto dealers, fees, and license plates. Provides that wholesale dealers are dealers subject to the jurisdiction of the dealer services division within the office of the secretary of state. (Jurisdiction over wholesale dealers was set to expire July 1, 2015.) Makes corresponding changes.

Effective: Upon passage.

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning motor vehicles.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1 SECTION 1. IC 9-29-17-1, AS AMENDED BY P.L.216-2014,
2 SECTION 150, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS
3 [EFFECTIVE UPON PASSAGE]: Sec 1. (a) Except as provided in
4 section 3 of this chapter, the fee for the first two (2) license plates
5 issued under IC 9-32-6-1 to a manufacturer or dealer is forty dollars
6 (\$40). There is an additional service charge of five dollars (\$5).
7 (b) The fee for each additional license plate under IC 9-32-6-5 for
8 a manufacturer or dealer is fifteen dollars (\$15). There is an additional
9 service charge of five dollars (\$5).
10 (c) The fee for a dealer promotional license plate established under
11 IC 9-32-6-2(b) is forty dollars (\$40).
12 (d) The fee for the first two (2) dealer-wholesale license plates
13 issued to an applicant under IC 9-32-6-2(a)(4) is one hundred
14 twenty-five dollars (\$125). The fee for each additional
15 dealer-wholesale license plate issued to the applicant is fifteen dollars

18 plates under this chapter according to the following classifications:

 22 forth in section 6(b) of this chapter.

23 (c) A dealer-wholesale license plate issued after June 30, 2014, ~~and~~
 24 ~~before July 1, 2015; expires June 30, 2015; is valid from the issue~~
 25 **date through the applicable expiration date set forth in section**
 26 **6(b), 6.5(b), or 6.5(c) of this chapter.**

27 (d) This section expires January 1, ~~2016; 2017.~~

28 SECTION 6. IC 9-32-6-6.5, AS ADDED BY P.L.62-2014,
 29 SECTION 16, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
 30 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 6.5. (a) This section applies to dealer license
 31 plates (~~other than dealer-wholesale license plates~~) issued after
 32 December 31, 2014.

33 (b) Dealer license plates issued to licensed dealers under this article
 34 are valid from the issue date through the expiration date as follows:

 36 with the letters A through B expire February 1 of each year.
 37 (2) Dealer license plates of a person whose business name begins
 38 with the letters C through D expire March 1 of each year.
 39 (3) Dealer license plates of a person whose business name begins

5 PASSAGE]: Sec. 7. (a) Except as provided in sections 8 and 9 of this
6 chapter, dealer-new, dealer-used, manufacturer, and *wholesale*
7 *dealer-wholesale* license plates may be used only on motor vehicles in
8 the:

- 9 (1) dealer's inventory being held for sale;
10 (2) usual operation of the manufacturer's or dealer's business;
11 (3) movement of the manufacturer's or dealer's inventory; or
12 (4) inventory of a manufacturer or dealer that is unattended by the
13 manufacturer or dealer or the dealer's agent for a maximum of ten
14 (10) days by a prospective buyer or a service customer.

15 (b) The license plates referenced in subsection (a) must be:

- 16 (1) primarily used or stored at an address within Indiana; or
17 (2) displayed on a vehicle being transported for purposes of sale
18 by a licensed Indiana dealer.

19 (c) *A person who violates this section commits a Class A infraction.*

20 (c) *This subsection expires January 1, 2016. A dealer-wholesale*
21 *license plate may not be issued or displayed after June 30, 2015.*

22 SECTION 8. IC 9-32-6-8, AS AMENDED BY P.L.62-2014,
23 SECTION 18, IS AMENDED TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE
24 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 8. Dealer-new, dealer-used, manufacturer, and
25 dealer-wholesale license plates may be used without restriction by a
26 manufacturer, a dealer, or an employee of a manufacturer or a dealer
27 in compliance with rules adopted by the secretary to prohibit use of the
28 plates solely to avoid payment of applicable taxes. ~~However, a~~

31 SECTION 9. IC 9-32-6-9, AS AMENDED BY P.L.62-2014,

33 UPON PASSAGE]: Sec. 9. Dealer-new, dealer-used, manufacturer, and
34 dealer-wholesale license plates may be used without restriction by a
35 designee of a dealer or a designee of a manufacturer under rules
36 adopted by the secretary. The rules must provide the following:

- 37 (1) The dealer or manufacturer is to be assessed and pay the
38 motor vehicle excise tax under IC 6-6-5 attributable to that part of
39 the total year that the designee operates the motor vehicle.
40 (2) The dealer or manufacturer shall report to the secretary the
41 date of assignment to a designee, the designee's name and
42 address, and the date of termination of the assignment within ten

2 (3) The tax calculated in subdivision (1) shall be paid within
3 thirty (30) days after the termination of the assignment to the
4 designee or at the time the dealer or manufacturer purchases

34 (10) An automotive mobility dealer.

35 (b) An automotive mobility dealer who engages in the business of:

36 (1) selling, installing, or servicing;

37 (2) offering to sell, install, or service; or

38 (3) soliciting or advertising the sale, installation, or servicing of;
39 equipment or modifications specifically designed to facilitate use or
40 operation of a vehicle by an individual who is disabled or aged must be
41 licensed under this article.

6 chapter must:

7 (1) be accompanied by payment of the applicable fee required
8 under IC 9-29-17;

9 (2) be on a form prescribed by the secretary;

10 (3) contain the information the secretary considers necessary to
11 enable the secretary to determine fully:

12 (A) the qualifications and eligibility of the applicant to receive
13 the license;

14 (B) the location of each of the applicant's places of business in
15 Indiana; and

16 (C) the ability of the applicant to conduct properly the business
17 for which the application is submitted; and

18 (4) contain evidence of a bond required in subsection (e).

19 An application for a wholesale dealer license must contain the
20 additional information required in section 3 of this chapter. ~~The~~
21 ~~secretary of state may not accept an application for a wholesale dealer~~
22 ~~license after June 30, 2015.~~

23 (b) An application for a license as a dealer must show whether the
24 applicant proposes to sell new or used motor vehicles, or both.

25 (c) An applicant who proposes to use the Internet or another
26 computer network to facilitate the sale of motor vehicles to consumers
27 in Indiana shall, if the applicant's activities may result in the creation
28 of business records outside Indiana, provide the division with the name,
29 address, and telephone number of the person who has control of those
30 business records. The secretary may not issue a license to a dealer who
31 transacts business in this manner and does not have an established
32 place of business in Indiana, except as proved under section 11(h) of
33 this chapter.

34 (d) The application must include an affidavit from:

35 (1) the person charged with enforcing a zoning ordinance, if one
36 exists; or

37 (2) the zoning enforcement officer under IC 36-7-4, if one exists;
38 who has jurisdiction over the real property where the applicant wants
39 to operate as a dealer. The affidavit must state that the proposed
40 location is zoned for the operation of a dealer's establishment. The
41 applicant may file the affidavit at any time after the filing of the
42 application. However, the secretary may not issue a license until the



1 applicant files the affidavit.

2 (e) Except as provided in subsection (g), a licensee shall maintain
3 a bond satisfactory to the secretary in the amount of twenty-five
4 thousand dollars (\$25,000). The bond must:

- 5 (1) be in favor of the state; and
6 (2) secure payment of fines, penalties, costs, and fees assessed by
7 the secretary after:
8 (A) notice;
9 (B) opportunity for a hearing; and
10 (C) opportunity for judicial review;
11 in addition to securing the payment of damages to a person
12 aggrieved by a violation of this article by the licensee after a
13 judgment has been issued.

14 (f) Service under this chapter shall be made in accordance with the
15 Indiana Rules of Trial Procedure.

16 (g) Instead of meeting the requirement in subsection (e), a licensee
17 may submit to the secretary evidence that the licensee is a member of
18 a risk retention group that is regulated by the Indiana department of
19 insurance.
