DIGEST OF INTRODUCED BILL

Citations Affected: Noncode.

Synopsis: Task force to study schools for the deaf and blind. Establishes the Indiana Schools for the Deaf and the Blind or Visually Impaired task force (task force) to evaluate and make recommendations to the budget committee relating to the operation of the physical plants of the Indiana School for the Deaf and the Indiana School for the Blind or Visually Impaired. Provides that the task force shall make its final recommendations to the budget committee on or before December 1, 2020. Establishes the task force advisory committee (advisory committee) to advise the task force on matters necessary for the task force to carry out its responsibilities. Provides that the department of administration shall provide staffing and administrative support for the task force and the advisory committee.

1 entitled to the minimum salary per diem or reimbursement for 2 traveling expenses and other expenses. Each member of the task 3 force or advisory committee who is a state employee but who is not 4 a member of the general assembly is entitled to reimbursement for 5 traveling expenses and other expenses actually incurred in 6 connection with the member's duties, as provided in the state travel 7 policies and procedures established by the department of 8 administration and approved by the budget agency. Each member 9 of the task force who is a member of the general assembly is 10 entitled to receive the same per diem, mileage, and travel 11 allowances paid to legislative members of interim study committees 12 established by the legislative council. Per diem, mileage, and travel 13 allowances paid under this subsection shall be paid from 14 appropriations made to the legislative council or the legislative 15 services agency. 16 (k) Meetings of the task force and the advisory committee must
