Synopsis: Noxious weed control. Adds Palmer amaranth (Amaranthus palmeri) and marestail (Conyza canadensis, also known as horseweed) to the list of detrimental plants that are required to be destroyed by certain persons under state law.

1	(6) Palmer amaranth (Amaranthus palmeri).
2	(7) Marestail (Conyza canadensis, also known as horseweed).
3	(6) (8) In residential areas only, noxious weeds and rank
4	vegetation.
5	The term does not include agricultural crops.
