### **HOUSE BILL No. 1629**

A BILL FOR AN ACT to amend the Indiana Code concerning education.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:

1	SECTION 1. IC 20-30-5-26 IS ADDED TO THE INDIANA CODE
2	AS A NEW SECTION TO READ AS FOLLOWS [EFFECTIVE JULY
3	1, 2025]: Sec. 26. (a) The governing body of each school
4	corporation shall provide instruction regarding the history of
5	communism as a part of a history course for students enrolled in
6	grades 9 through 12.
7	(b) The department shall develop curricula or approve
8	instruction previously developed by the department for use by
9	school corporations under subsection (a).
10	(c) Curriculum developed or approved under subsection (b)
11	must include age appropriate instruction on the following:
12	(1) The history of communism and domestic communist
13	movements in the United States, including tactics used by
14	communist groups during the movements.
15	(2) An overview of the atrocities committed in foreign
16	countries under the guidance of communism.
17	(3) A comparative analysis of political ideologies, including



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1	communism, Marxism, and totalitarianism, and how these
2	ideologies conflict with the principles of freedom and
3	democracy essential to the founding principles of the United
4	States.
5	(4) The increasing threat of communism in the United States
6	and to allies of the United States, including the events of the
7	Cultural Revolution in the People's Republic of China and
8	other mass killings from communist regimes.
9	(5) The economic, industrial, and political events that have
10	preceded and proceeded communist revolutions.
11	(6) The harmful repercussions of communist policies in Cuba
12	and Latin America, as well as the societal impact, burden, and
13	threat to the United States the policies pose.
14	(7) The effect of communism in Europe, with a focus on Soviet
15	labor camps and human right abuses.
16	(8) Oppressive effects of communism in Asia, including a
17	history of the People's Republic of China's ongoing
18	authoritarian practices.
19	(9) A comparative analysis of the threats posed by political
