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1           A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION recognizing FFA and all  
2 of its work to advance the quality of agricultural education both  
3 locally and nationally.

4           *Whereas, The FFA national organization, established in*  
5 *1928, and Indiana FFA, established in 1929, have prepared*  
6 *future generations for the challenges of feeding a growing*  
7 *population;*

8           *Whereas, The National FFA encompasses the 50 states and*  
9 *two U.S. territories and continues to grow, with 653,359*  
10 *members and 8,568 local chapters, while the Indiana FFA*  
11 *membership has grown to more than 12,200 members in 209*  
12 *chapters;*

13           *Whereas, The FFA motto of "Learning to Do, Doing to Learn,*  
14 *Earning to Live, Living to Serve" has been upheld and applied*  
15 *by the organization by focusing on the individual student and*  
16 *providing a path to achievement in premier leadership,*  
17 *personal growth, and career success through agricultural*  
18 *education;*

19           *Whereas, The organization's directive is to develop*  
20 *agricultural leaders, increase awareness of the importance of*  
21 *agriculture, strengthen the confidence of the students involved,*  
22 *promote the choice of agriculture as a career, encourage*  
23 *agricultural experience programs, highlight wise management*  
24 *of community resources, develop members' interpersonal skills*  
25 *and character, promote cooperation and healthy lifestyles, and*  
26 *encourage excellence in scholarship; and*



1       *Whereas, FFA Week started in 1947 as an opportunity for*  
2       *members, alumni, and sponsors to celebrate and advocate for*  
3       *agricultural education, and the FFA will be celebrated this*  
4       *year February 16-23: Therefore,*

5               *Be it resolved by the House of Representatives*  
6               *of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,*  
7               *the Senate concurring:*

8       SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly recognizes  
9       FFA as an integral part of agricultural education both locally  
10      and nationally.
