1           A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION recognizing FFA and all of its  
2 work to advance the quality of agricultural education both locally and  
3 nationally.

4           *Whereas, The FFA national organization, established in*  
5 *1928, and Indiana FFA, established in 1929, have prepared*  
6 *future generations for the challenges of feeding a growing*  
7 *population;*

8           *Whereas, National FFA encompasses 50 states and two*  
9 *U.S. territories, representing 629,327 members and 7,757*  
10 *local chapters, and Indiana FFA has more than 11,500*  
11 *members and 204 chapters;*

12           *Whereas, The FFA motto of "Learning to Do, Doing to*  
13 *Learn, Earning to Live, Living to Serve" has been upheld and*  
14 *applied by the organization by focusing on the individual*  
15 *student and providing a path to achievement in premier*  
16 *leadership, personal growth, and career success through*  
17 *agricultural education;*

18           *Whereas, The organization's directive is to develop*  
19 *agricultural leaders, increase awareness of the importance*  
20 *of agriculture, strengthen the confidence of the students*  
21 *involved, promote the choice of agriculture as a career,*
