




## HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

1 2	A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION honoring the Gold Star Volunteers of the Indiana State Archives.
3	Whereas, Since 1991, dedicated volunteers have
4	processed and indexed thousands of cubic feet of historical
5	Indiana documents, including land records, naturalization
6	records, institutional records, photographs, and original
7	House and Senate bills;
8	Whereas, As of the end of 2016, eight volunteers earned
9	Gold Star status by contributing more than 2,500 hours of
10	their time to the Indiana State Archives;
11	Whereas, Dale Armstrong, Ann January, Boyd Obermeyer,
12	Anne Rodick, and Tom York have accumulated more than
13	2,500 hours of volunteer time;
14	Whereas, Mary Etta Boren has volunteered more than
15	5,000 hours;
16	Whereas, Sandy Ricketts and Barbara Wood have given
17	more than 10,000 hours of their time to the Indiana State
18	Archives; and
19	Whereas, These Gold Star Volunteers and many others who
20	contributed their time to the Indiana State Archives made it
21	possible to search more than 1.5 million names online,
22	allowing researchers from around the world to explore
23	Indiana's history: Therefore,



1	Be it resolved by the House of Representatives
2	of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana,
3	the Senate concurring:
4	SECTION 1. That the Indiana General Assembly thanks these Gold
5	Star Volunteers for their many hours of dedicated service to the Indiana
6	State Archives, work that has preserved Indiana's history and made it
7	accessible to all Hoosiers.
